Meeting Minutes: June 14, 2016

President Renee Forte called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm. The minutes from May 19th 2016 meeting were reviewed. A motion to accept was made by Christine Koviak and seconded by Paul Perchansky.

Correspondence: President Renee Forte sent out thank you notes to the tour companies of the Cleveland Ohio & Washington DC trips.

Treasurers Report: Treasurer George Mellon presented the Treasurer's report. A motion to accept was made by Rocco Mariano and seconded by Barbara Haraschak. All were in favor, none opposed.

Old Business:

Ways and Means/General Fund: President Renee Forte explained the importance of fundraisers. There will be 1-2 General Fund fundraisers done per year. We will be having 2 fundraisers per month. We need to work together as one. 90 % of these fundraisers will go toward the student & 10 % to General Fund. Barbara Haraschak volunteered to help with daytime sorting of the fundraisers.

Publicity: Rocco Mariano agreed to take over for publicity.

Concession Stand: President Renee Forte stated that they need help for set up & clean up for the home football games. Mr Stefanko spoke about a punch card that will be effective this marching season to all volunteers as an incentive.

Chaperones: President Renee Forte stated that all chaperones need 3 clearances per district policy.

Band Store: There will be a sale in August during Band Camp.

Committees:

Relay for Life: Marching Band did not participate in Relay for Life because they contacted the incorrect person & no one forwarded the information.

Band Director's Report:

Band Information: Mr. Stefanko stated that the count for this upcoming marching season was just over 60 band members & 2 color guards. He has been in touch with Joelle Wittner to get the word out that we are looking for color guards. Mr.

Stefanko also stated that we would not be getting new uniforms this year. We would have to make due with the old uniforms & making repairs. He also mentioned that this years band trip would be to Florida, most likely in April. The deposit will be due in November. He is looking into prices regarding flying or taking a bus. If they fly then Jeff Haraschak would drive the Penske truck with the band equipment & uniforms.

Rocco Mariano questioned Mr. Stefanko regarding the Band Boosters becoming a non profit. President Renee Forte also stated that 2 parents wanted more information from the CPA regarding this also. Mr. Stefanko called Ron Gunther CPA & he answered all the questions that were asked by the group. Most of the questions were regarding fees. Ron Gunther is supposed to be putting together a proposal for everyone to look over before a decision is made.

Fundraising: We will be having a Mums sale during the month of July for pre-orders.

New Business: Nothing to report at this time.
