Luzerne County Band Fest!

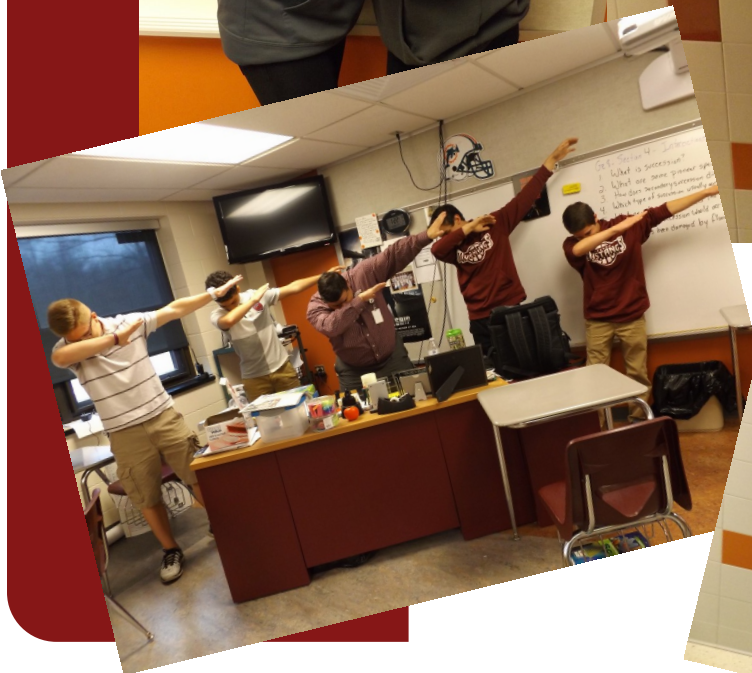

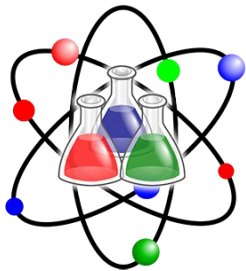

Students Ample Singh, Genna Kirpa, Madison Light, Madison Dulina, Desiree Schechterly, and David Greybosh presented their projects to various judges and all had a great outcome. After they presented, the students were allowed to walk around the Wilkes Campus. They all enjoyed their time at Wilkes and being in a college campus.

Their projects and places were: Schechterly's project tested whether the shape of an ice cube affects its melting speed, placing 2nd.

Dulina's project tested whether the amount of times you twisted a copper wire around a D-battery affected how many paperclips it could pick up, placing 2nd. Singh's project tested whether the sugars in fruit and honey are the same as regular table sugars, also placing 2nd. 4. Pour over confectioners' sugar in a large mixing bowl
5. Beat until smooth; pour into an
