## COLLEGE EDUCATION IN HIGH SCHOOL AT A REDUCED RATE

Penn State Hazleton is offering area high school students the opportunity to experience a college-level course while earning credits at a discounted rate right at their own high school.

### Fall 2017 Course Offering

#### **Effective Speech (CAS 100A) 3 credits**

Principles of communication, implemented through presentation of speeches, with some attention to group discussion and message evaluation.

This general education course studies the purposeful use of oral communication as a means of addressing practical problems, both professional and civic. It is designed to introduce students to principles of effective public speaking, implemented through the design and presentation of individual speeches and through practice in message analysis and evaluation.

### Student Application Process

The following credentials must be provided to the Admissions Office at Penn State Hazleton:

- Nondegree Enrollment Form (enclosed)
- Current, official high school transcript
- SAT/ACT or PSAT/PLAN scores
- Statement from, teacher, counselor, or principal in support of the student's enrollment at Penn State

Students will be contacted by the campus with an admissions decision. If the student is accepted to enroll in the Lion Scholars Dual Enrollment program, the campus Academic Advising Center will coordinate course scheduling and new student orientation.

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## **Estimated 2017 Costs**

Penn State Hazleton will offer a 75% tuition discount for the course offered through the Hazleton Area School District at Hazleton Area High School and the Hazleton Area Academy of Sciences.

The student is responsible for paying 25% of the current tuition rate, in addition to information technology and facilities fees.

The table below reflects the current costs for the 2016-2017 academic year. Official tuition rates for the 2017-2018 academic year will be available in mid-July 2017.
