Who Can Apply?

- *Current high school juniors
 - *Students who hope to become a Physician.
 - *Students who are underrepresented in medicine including Black/African American and Hispanic/Latino backgrounds.
- (HRSA grant requirements per the need to increase underrepresented individuals in medicine).*

Program Components:

This year's summer component will be virtual due to the pandemic. Students will attend sessions to learn about the pathway to becoming a doctor. They will also examine current issues in healthcare, participate in virtual clinical simulations, begin senior-year college planning, and receive mentoring from medical students.

Additional Participation Benefits:

A \$500 stipend is provided if students are actively engaged in the virtual sessions, and you will also earn credit and transcript hours for participation. Students will also be eligible for Fall fieldtrips to various university campuses based on summer performance. A transcript of participation will also be provided for you to include with applications.
