 21. Graph the points $A(2, 1), B(2, -5), C(-4, -5)$, and $D(-4, 1)$.
Draw the segments connecting A, B, C , and D in order.
Are the lengths of the sides of $ABCD$ the same? Explain.
 22. A crow flies to a point that is 1 mile east and 20 miles south of its starting point. How far does the crow fly?

Quadrilateral PQSR has coordinates as follows:

$P(0, 0), Q(-1, 4), R(8, 2)$, and $S(7, 6)$.

 24. What is the perimeter of $PQSR$?
 25. What is the midpoint of $\overline{QR}$?
