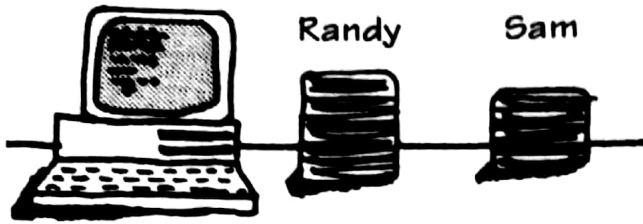

Randy has 63 computer disks. Sam has 45. How many more does Randy have?



"How many more" is a clue word. It means to compare the two numbers by subtracting them.

$$\begin{array}{r} 63 \\ - 45 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
$$\begin{array}{r} 5 \ 13 \\ \cancel{63} \\ - 45 \\ \hline 18 \end{array}$$

Randy has 18 more than Sam.

2. One month 328 students were absent at Madison School. The next month 205 were absent. How many more were absent in the first month?

4. Last week it was  $36^\circ$  in Minnesota and  $95^\circ$  in Florida. How much warmer was it in Florida?

5. This spring 81 new trees were planted in the park. There are now 151 trees in all. How many trees were there before?

6. Jan's kite string is 250 feet long. Tia's kite string is 75 feet shorter than Jan's. How long is Tia's kite string?
