COVID GUIDELINES 2022-2023

- 1. Individuals who are exposed to COVID-19 are recommended to wear a high quality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 6 after exposure.
- 2. Anyone with COVID symptoms and is in school:
 - a. Must mask
 - b. Send to nurse's office
 - c. Send home and stay home until have test results
 - d. Get tested immediately
- 3. If test positive:
 - a. Isolate for 5 days for date of symptom onset (will be given quarantine days for absences at school for these days)
 - b. Stay home from school for those 5 days, isolated from family members
- 4. May return to school on 6th day as long as they are fever free for 24 hours prior to 6th day.
- 5. Must continue to wear a mask when returning to school for an additional 5 days (through day 10, mask can come off on day 11)
- 6. If test positive but have NO symptoms and are following isolation protocol above and then become symptomatic, person must restart the isolation/quarantine days from the date of symptom onset. Then will also be required to mask an additional 5 days when returning to school through day 10.
- 7. ALL POSITIVES must be reported to the school nurse and to the Health Liaison, Terese Gentilesco, and then put on COVID tracking spread sheet
- 8. Family members of positive cases will not have to quarantine regardless of vaccination status unless they are symptomatic, then they must stay home and be tested.
- 9. Classroom exposures:
 - a. Inform class they were potentially exposed to a positive case, and they need to monitor for symptoms, get tested if become symptomatic.
