DAYLIGHTS SAVING TIME

Each year, in the wee hours of a Sunday morning in March, 60 minutes vanish from the clock and the time reappears each year in November! No, it is not a magic trick — it is Daylight Saving Time!

Daylight Saving Time was created to make better use of the long sunlight hours of the summer. By "springing" clocks forward an hour, we move an hour of daylight from the morning to the evening. On the first Sunday in November, we "fall back" and rewind our clocks to return to Standard Time.

Benjamin Franklin first suggested the idea in an essay he wrote. It was originally instituted during World War I and then again during World War II in order to take advantage of longer daylight hours and save energy for war production. It did not become a standard practice in the United States until 1966. We will fall back on Sunday, November 6th.

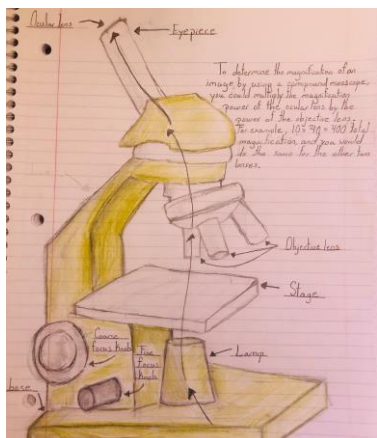


STUDENT SPOTLIGHT

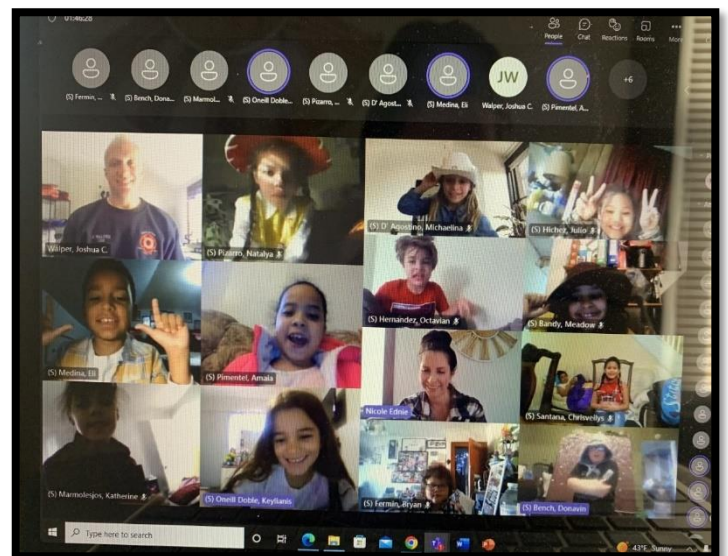
