What is WARM LINE?

The Warm Line is a telephone support line where you will be able to talk to specially trained peers with lived experience that can listen to concerns and offer support. The Warm Line Peer Responder will have a unique perspective on your issues since they may have experienced many of the same feelings.

Why would I call WARM LINE?

If you are feeling isolated, anxious or overwhelmed, and need someone to listen and feel heard.

When can I call WARM LINE?

Monday & Tuesday: 5p.m.- 9p.m. Wednesday- Sunday: 1p.m.- 9p.m.
