

What Should I Bring to Kindergarten?

Coming to Kindergarten is always an exciting time and a fun time for students to shop for school supplies. While we have all of the educational supplies ready to go, below is a list of items that would help your child.

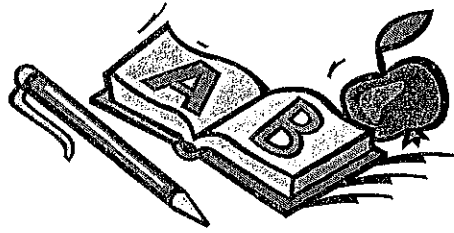
Kindergarten Supplies

- 1 pack of 6 or 12 glue sticks
- 1 Activity Book (ex: coloring, dot to dot, hidden picture, etc.)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- A change of clothes (shirt, socks, pants, underwear) inside a ziplock bag for your child to keep in their backpack
- 1 clear or mesh backpack
- A set of headphones (sent in to school during the first week of school) inside a ziplock bag labeled with your child's name – **no earbuds, please**
- 1 reusable water bottle

We will supply pencils, crayons, a glue stick, paper, white board, eraser, scissors, and a pencil case for each student. We look forward to seeing you all in Kindergarten!

Back to School Supply List for 1st Grade

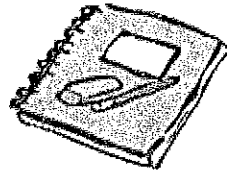
On the first day of school your child will receive a basic supply of pencils, erasers, crayons, a glue stick, and scissors in a pencil case. Homework folders needed for the year will also be provided.

We appreciate if you would kindly send your child with these supplies to be used throughout the year. ALL supplies may be sent in the second week of school, which is the week of September 11, 2023.

- 1 box of yellow #2 pencils
- 1 pack of glue sticks
- 1 yellow highlighter
- crayons (24 pack)
- tissues
- disinfecting wipes
- hand sanitizer
- hand soap
- HEADPHONES – if your child has working headphones from Kindergarten they may be used (please check before sending in). If not, a pair must be purchased for use with laptops in the classroom.

Please do not send your child to school with binders or any art kits.

Please remember to label your child's personal items such as backpacks, lunchboxes, sweatshirts, and coats. Thank you very much!

BACK TO SCHOOL INFORMATION FOR SECOND GRADE

On the first day of school, your child will receive a pencil case filled with pencils, crayons, a glue stick, and an eraser. Scissors and folders will also be provided. Your individual teacher may ask for additional items throughout the year.

Students will need headphones that are compatible with their school laptop.

Clear or mesh backpacks should be used.

- Hand sanitizer

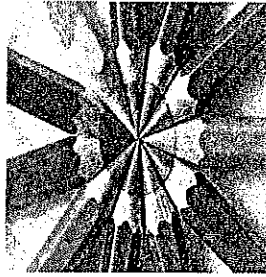
Please do not send in binders or any art kits. If any special project requires art supplies from home, a note will be sent from your child's teacher.

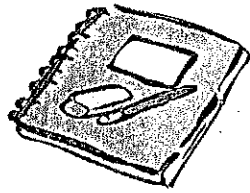

Dear Parents/Guardians of 2023-2024 Sixth Grade Students,

To help the students stay organized, we have compiled the following list of school supplies that will be needed for Sixth Grade:

- **One** sturdy two-pocket folder to be labeled "**Take-Home Folder.**" In this folder, teachers will send home important forms, letters, and information during the school year.
- **Reading-** one composition notebook (*the kind without the spiral binding*), sharpened #2 pencils and erasers
- **English & Spelling** – 2 composition notebooks (*the kind without the spiral binding*), sharpened #2 pencils and erasers
- **Math** – one 3-subject notebook, sharpened #2 pencils and erasers
- **Social Studies/Science** – one 3-subject notebook, sharpened #2 pencils and erasers

Other needed items:

- 2 boxes of tissues for your homeroom teacher (generic brand is fine)
- District-approved backpack (helps the student stay organized)
- One sturdy set of headphones for your child's laptop use

Optional but helpful:

- One box of colored pencils for classroom use

Wish List item for the classroom:

- Extra #2 pencils and erasers during the year
- Extra boxes of tissues during the year (generic brand is fine)

Items that are NOT needed:

The children **do not need** a Trapper Keeper/Binder. This item is bulky, doesn't fit inside the desk, and in most cases leads to overstuffing and disorganization. Please **avoid** three-ring binders and thick, expandable file folders as these are also **too large** for proper storage. Thank you, and we look forward to a productive, enjoyable year with your child.
