Request to Unblock Web Domain or Web Page

As part of the Children’s Internet Protection Act (CIPA), the District is required to have in place a “filtering/blocking device” on all computers with Internet access. The filter/blocking device must attempt to protect against access to subjects that are obscene or harmful to minors and child pornography. The district is currently in compliance with CIPA guidelines.

Only authorized network administrators may disable the blocking or filtering measure to enable access for bona fide research or other lawful purposes. **The category of the blocked site will be reviewed with Administration and removed only with their approval.**

Unblocking a Web Domain or Web Page

Some web sites are unintentionally blocked by generalized filtering rules that make our Internet filter faster and more proactive.
