

Use Different Kinds of Sentences

There are four kinds of sentences. Each kind of sentence has a different purpose. Use the end mark that fits the purpose. Start every sentence with a capital letter.

Kind of Sentence	Example
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Statement Make a statement to tell something. End with a period. 	We are going to the mountain. We will climb to the top.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Question Ask a question to find out something. End with a question mark. 	When are you going? How will you get there?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Command Give a command to tell someone what to do. End with a period. 	Drive to Littleton. Take a left at the light.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exclamation Use an exclamation to express a strong feeling. End with an exclamation point. 	The view from the top is beautiful! This is the best view in the world!
