- Sources of information, such as newspapers, television, and the internet
- The media reported that he won the election with a miraculous landslide.



Produce

- Verb
- Make; create
- I am going to produce a beautiful Valentine's Day card to give to my wonderful husband.



React

- Verb
- Respond to
- Nicole reacted very quickly to the fire alarm.



Speak

- Verb
- Use oral language
- Please speak to me in a quieter tone.



Technology

- Noun
- Machines, equipment, and ways of doing things that are based on modern knowledge about science
- The new phone technology makes it so much easier to communicate.



Transmit

- Verb
- Send or give out
- Please transmit the important message through email.



Enrich

- Verb
- Make better; improve
- Our Language Arts teacher **enriched** our minds with fun and creative learning activities.

- Verb
- Say; show; communicate
- Isabel was able to express her creativity and ideas through beautiful poetry.




Learn
