GUIDANCE

ASVAB

Any 10th to 12th grade student interested in taking the Armed Services Vocational Battery - ASVAB Exam, please sign up in your school's guidance office. Career Center and STEM school students are testing on February 15th, and High School students are scheduled to test on February 23rd. Both exams will be held at the Career Center in their large group room starting at 8 AM. Please take note of the date your school is testing when you sign up. Space is limited so sign up early.

<u>PSAT 10</u>

Attention Sophomores: The PSAT-10 will be administered at Hazleton Area High School on Wednesday, April 26th. Students interested must sign up in guidance. The cost is \$18, which is payable in cash or check made payable to HASD at the time of registration. Tests are limited, and paid registrations only will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, with a deadline to sign up by February 17th. The PSAT is a practice test for the SAT.

NURSE'S OFFICE

The Pennsylvania Department of Health mandates a physical examination be completed by a care provider/physician on all students entering 11th grade.

The Pa Dept of Health also mandates all students receive a Meningococcal (MCV) vaccination on or after the student's 16th birthday to enter 12th grade. Please keep this in mind and discuss with your care provider/physician at the time of 11th grade physical exam.

The state of Pennsylvania requires that all students entering 12th grade must have a 2nd dose of Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV). If the first dose was given at 16 years of age or older, then only one dose is required, and that shall count as the 12th grade dose.

Written proof of this immunization from your physician must be returned to the school nurse prior to the first day of 12th grade. Failure to provide the necessary documentation will put your child at risk for exclusion from school.
