

VC and CVC Words

VC and CVC words are simply words that follow the vowel-consonant(VC) or vowel-consonant-vowel(VCV) pattern. The vowel sounds in VC and CVC words are considered closed or short vowels.

Examples: at, it, sat, hit

Important to note: This is a critical time in a child's life as a reader. Children are expected to know all the consonants and short vowel sounds. Without this understanding, children will struggle. Please use this web site as a resource to teach VC and CVC words.
