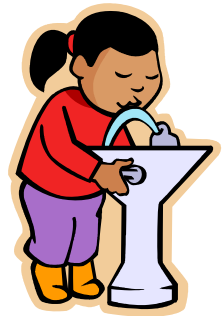
## dr Shape Book
