Middle Sounds

This is the child's ability to isolate and categorize the middle sound in a word.

 $\ensuremath{^{**}}$ Parents - When teaching middle sounds, only use 3 letter words that follow the "cvc" pattern

(cvc = consonant , vowel, consonant – sit, hit, sat and so on)

Example:

- ◆The middle sound in the word "fat" is /a/
- ◆The middle sound in the word "mit" is /ĭ /
- ◆The ending sound in the word "bet" is /ĕ/
