The 2023 Hazleton Rotary Technical Scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000.

The following criteria will be used in the screening of applications for the 2023 Hazleton Rotary Technical Scholarship.

- 1. Candidates must be pursuing technical study ranging from a certificate program of less than one year's duration to an associate or baccalaureate degree program at an accredited institution.
- 2. Candidates must reside in the geographic boundaries of the Hazleton Area School District.
- 3. Applicants can be of any age.
- 4. Applications are due no later than **April 21, 2023**.
- 5. This is a one-time award.
- 6. Applications will be scored using the following point system:

Academic Information30 pointsEssay20 pointsEmployment, Activities, & Service30 pointsFinancial Need20 points

Typical job functions would include service, troubleshooting, and repair of sophisticated manufacturing machinery and systems. Installing of manufacturing systems, many of which are computer operated, and overall preventative maintenance are typical job functions. Work in a variety of medical technologies and in nursing is also suitable. Candidates with mechanical, quantitative or scientific aptitude with good analytical problem-solving skills would be ideally suited for these careers.
