

2024 Greater Hazleton Area Civic Partnership Technical Scholarship Application

The Greater Hazleton Area Civic Partnership Technical Scholarship Award is \$4,000 per year for up to two years, or for a total maximum scholarship of \$8,000.

The following criteria will be used in the screening of applications for the 2024 Greater Hazleton Area Civic Partnership Technical Scholarship.

- 1. Candidates must be pursuing technical study ranging from a certificate program of less than one year's duration to an associate or baccalaureate degree program at an accredited institution.
- 2. Candidates must either attend a school in the Hazleton Area School District; **or** attend school at ICS, MMI, Marian, or a school in the Weatherly Area School District.
- 3. Adult learners residing within the boundaries of the Hazleton Area School District are welcomed to apply.
- 4. Candidates must be in good academic standing and must achieve a 2.75 or equivalent average each semester in their post-secondary studies in order to renew the scholarship.
- 5. Applications are due no later than April 19, 2024.
- 6. Applications will be scored using the following point system:

Academic Information 30 points
Course of Study 10 points
Essay 20 points
Employment, Activities, & Service 30 points
Financial Need 10 points

Programs that qualify for the Civic Partnership Technical Scholarship

- Manufacturing or Industrial Technology
- Information Science and Technology
- Medical Technologies
- Nursing
- > Engineering and Engineering Technology
- Production Technology

Typical job functions would include service, troubleshooting, and repair of sophisticated manufacturing machinery and systems. Installing of manufacturing systems, many of which are computer operated, and overall preventative maintenance are also typical job functions. Work in a variety of medical technologies and in nursing is also suitable. Candidates with mechanical, quantitative or scientific aptitude with good analytical problem-solving skills would be ideally suited for these careers.
