The East Penn Section of ASHE is pleased to announce the Robert L. Brown and Robert L. Donovan Memorial Scholarship Program. This program will award a minimum of three scholarships to high school seniors who are enrolled or planning to enroll in a program leading to a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or Civil and Construction Engineering Technology.

Application instructions, eligibility requirements and the application follow. The completed application must be emailed/postmarked by April 22, 2022 to be considered for the Scholarship Award. 1. **AMOUNT:** A minimum of three scholarships of \$5,000 each will be awarded in late May 2022. The selected recipients will be notified by email or letter.

2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- a. The applicant must attend a school that serves the East Penn Section of ASHE (Berks, Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, Northampton and Schuylkill Counties) and must be a citizen of the United States.
- b. The applicant must be a senior in high school.
- c. The applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a program leading toward a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or Civil and Construction Engineering Technology.
- 3. **EVALUATION:** Each applicant will be evaluated using the rating system described below:
 - a. Grade Point Average 35 points maximum
 - Student will be rated based upon their cumulative grade point average.
 - b. Honors and Activities 30 points maximum
 - Student will be rated based upon a subjective evaluation of activities, honors and employment history.
 - c. Career Goals Paragraph 25 points maximum
 - Student paragraph on career goals will be rated. Grammar, neatness, and spelling as well as content and clarity of ambitions will be considered.
 - d. Guidance Counselor or Math/Science Teacher Recommendation 10 points maximum
 - Student will be rated upon written recommendations from their guidance counselor including student's character, academic standing, financial status and other comments.
