This scholarship was founded by friends of the Kostick family to honor Dan's memory and celebrate his love for life, community, and family. This is a one-year nonrenewable \$250 reward.

One of Dan's greatest skills was his ability to recognize and nurture the strengths he saw in others. Dan loved exploring new places, traveling to the mountains and beaches, and meeting new people. Because of this, he instilled this sense of adventure in his family as well. He had a gift for making everyone feel special. Dan Kostick was a walking, talking example of how to lift people up and find joy in others' good fortune. He lived a life of deep faith and gratitude for everyone he loved. He had an entrepreneurial spirit and his greatest strength was to nurture the abilities that he saw in others. He was a world class communicator, freely expressing his affection and admiration. Compassion, thoughtfulness and empathy were also part of who Dan was. He was an avid runner, biker, hiker, and swimmer until the age of 86.

- Must be a high school senior attending Hazleton Area, MMI or Marian Catholic High School
- Must be a hard-working student and athlete
- Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree at any accredited 2 or 4-year college/university or trade school as a full-time student
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must submit 300–500-word essay
