

The Pennsylvania State Police Hill Impact program is a multi-phased program with each phase consisting of 16-week courses that focus on physical fitness, paramilitary disciplines, and law enforcement education. Each phase builds on the last, giving the participants the opportunity to learn and grow in the program. Hill Impact cadets will meet one day a week for two and a half hours in the evening and one Saturday a month for four hours.

Each participant must adhere to the rules and regulations set forth by the program.

The Pennsylvania State Police Hill Impact Program is a program designed to strengthen the relationship between law enforcement and those individuals looking to seek a career in law enforcement.

Hill Impact will provide participants between the ages of 15-18 years old with exposure to many different facets of law enforcement training and education such as The History of the Pennsylvania State Police and Principles of Law Enforcement. Participants will study the Pennsylvania Crimes Code and Vehicle Code along with Rules of Criminal Procedure and a host of other topics.
