When it became apparent that the football stadium would not materialize, the members of the Alumni Association decided to use the money that had been collected to fund an annual scholarship for a deserving member of the senior class. With the closing of W.H.H.S., it was decided that the recipient must reside in the geographical area of W.H.H.S. In 1992.

Beginning with the class of 1979, a scholarship has been given annually. The Alumni Association reviews the applications, taking into consideration a variety of factors, among them, financial need, scholastic achievement, and community involvement.
