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Rules and Eligibility	
1	At least two \$2000 scholarships will be awarded.
2	Winners must, at the time the scholarships are awarded, be accepted as a provisional or full-time student to a degree program at an accredited institution.
3	Eligible accredited institutions are limited to Universities, Colleges, Junior Colleges, Community Colleges and Technical Schools having at least a two-year degree program.
4	The applicant's primary residence must be within a White Haven telephone exchange (i.e. "443") or within the 18661 zip code.
5	Proceeds of the scholarships will be issued jointly to the winners and to their chosen colleges, universities, or accredited institutions.
6	Applications will be accepted through Wednesday April 12, 2023. Applications received after that date will not be eligible for award consideration.
8	All applications will be equally considered. Judging and award recommendations will be by an independent, impartial panel (not affiliated with the White Haven Lions Club). Applicant names, addresses, and contact information will not be visible to judges.
