

Flute Scales

- Scale 38:** Measures 38-44. Ascending: Bb4-C5-D5-Eb5-F6. Descending: F6-Eb5-D5-C5-Bb4.

Play each scale at least one octave at the best possible speed.

Add octaves if possible to extend the range for more consideration.

Scales can be played from the page in auditions.

Memorized scales get more consideration.

Tongue all notes.
